

“La Bodega” is located in the town of Pazos, Verín, Ourense and is part of the Monterrei wine making designation of origin group.

Our location is special in that it is situated 600m above sea level and has a climate that is a mixture of an atlantic climate (due to its relative proximity to the sea in Galicia) and a continental climate.

Here, we produce white wines that have strong aromas with a high acidic content taken from our very own region of Galicia as well as red wines that are produced using a local Mencía grape that is aged over three months in French and American oak.

“ALMA DE BLANCO” white wine:  
Godello grape.

Fermented in stainless steel wine tanks at a controlled temperature.

In 2009, we won the Silver Medal in the Brussels World Championships, the Bronze Medal at the “Challenge International du Vin” and a Prestige Trophy at the “Citadelles du Vin” competition.
